The Flagship Mono Act Competition

General Guidelines:

1. This is a solo event, however an additional helper is allowed.
2. Participants are required to register [here](#) with all the relevant details requested in the registration form filled. Participants who fail to register within the stipulated time will not be allowed to participate.
3. Event will be conducted in 2 rounds: First round will be conducted online, where the participants are required to share their entries at theatre@iiml-manfestvarchasva.com. Participants qualified to final round will perform at MV.
4. Participants are required to send any of the below two for the first round:
 - a. A past performance of the participant doing Mono Act shot within last 2 years.
 - b. A new recording of the participant doing either of monologue, mime, narration, method acting.
5. Participants has the freedom to choose their act from any of the two forms:
 - a. Narration – Narrate a story, participant will have to do the dialogue presentation themselves for characters in the story.
 - b. Method Acting – Participant can choose a portion from any film of his choice and perform the character.
6. It is an individual event however multiple entries are welcome from the same college.
7. The participant is required to perform either in English or Hindi.
8. Obscenity (at the discretion of judges), defaming any political party or religious groups of any kind, shall not be allowed and may lead to disqualification.
9. Decisions of the judges shall be final and binding in case of any conflict.

Round 1: Preliminary Round

1. This will be an online round; students are required to send their submissions to theatre@iiml-manfestvarchasva.com.
2. The video can be of a maximum duration of 1 minute.
3. The video can be either a recording of their past performance or a new performance.



4. Last date to register and submit the entry will be 20th January 2024. Naming convention: ***MV 2023-24_Izhaar_<Participant Name>***. For any additional details, you can write a mail to theatre@iiml-manfestvarchasva.com.
5. Top 10 participants will be shortlisted for the final round where he/she is required to perform at MV.
6. Selected participants will be informed about their selection with further details in due time.

Round 2: Final Round

1. Final round of the event will happen at IIM Lucknow campus, where the participants are required to perform live on stage.
2. Final round for shortlisted candidates will take place during Manfest-Varchasva 2023-24 from 9th to 11th Feb. The final schedule will be communicated on the website and Instagram page.
3. Each participant will be given a maximum of 5 minutes for performance and 2 minutes for Q&A.
4. If in case the story/ dialogue is inspired from someone else's creation, the same needs to be informed in advance.
5. Participants exceeding the provided time limit will attract negative points.
6. The soundtrack (if any) for the campus round should be mailed to us on or before 6th February 2024. In case of a deadline not being met, the organizers will not be responsible for any mishaps with regards to it.
7. Participants must bring their soundtrack on a pen drive on the day of the event

Judging Criteria

Performance will be judged based on originality, acting, story, dialogue, script, use of mic & space, message.
