General guidelines:

1. The event would be conducted in two rounds (Online Prelims + Offline Finals).
2. Participants need to register online on – [SUR REGISTRATION FORM](#).
3. Only registered individuals would be allowed to participate.
4. The registered candidates would be required to send video entries for the preliminary round.
5. The “Offline finals” for the qualified candidates would be conducted at IIM Lucknow’s campus.
6. Participants are welcome to enhance their performance with either karaoke or a single musical instrument of their choice.
7. The use of any foul or inappropriate language during the performance is strictly forbidden and will result in immediate disqualification.
8. Decision of the judges will be final and irrevocable, ensuring fairness and integrity in the evaluation process.
9. If a participant is unable to attend, they are kindly requested to inform the organizing committee at least 7 days prior to the event.

<p>Preliminary Round</p>	<p>Selection Process through Video Entries</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deadline for Submission: 26th January 2025 • Time Limit: 2–3 minutes • Participants can submit a video of any recent past performance or a live recording of their performance. • You may use either karaoke or a musical instrument as accompaniment. • The performance does not need to be an original composition. • Submissions must be in video format (suggested format: .mp4). • File Naming Convention: MV2024-25_Sur_Name. • The top entries will be shortlisted for the finals, and shortlisted participants will be notified in due time. • Participants must email their submissions to music@iiml-manfestvarchasva.com after completing the registration process for “Sur.” <p>Submissions from teams without registrations would be considered null and void</p>
